CALL FOR PAPERS

The 17th Symposium of Australian Gastronomy will be held in Adelaide, South Australia, 12-16 November, 2009. The 17th Symposium will celebrate the 25 years since the first symposium was held in 1984, also in Adelaide, and will honour the contributions made by as many of the original participants as can attend.

This Symposium's theme marks another return, in this case to a fundamental concept: **economy**. This theme is to be interpreted as widely as possible, and accordingly we welcome papers on topics including, but not limited to, sustainability, frugality, simplicity, kitchen economies, eco-economics, local food economies, food habits in hard times, political economy, moral economy, and national and global economy as these related to food culture and/or gastronomy.

Abstracts of no more than 500 words, together with a 100-word biography of the presenter(s) and any special audiovisual requirements (a computer and data projector will be available), should be submitted by email to the paper convener, Rachel Ankeny (rachel.ankeney@adelaide.edu.au), by **1 August 2009**. Abstracts will be reviewed and papers selected on the basis of merit and relevance to the overall theme. For those papers selected, presentations will be limited to 20 minutes, and full manuscripts will be due one month after the Symposium (15 December 2009).
