- Applicant's Academic Performance: Minimum requirement is 70% average in all Level 2 and Level 3 courses taken in the Bachelor of Media or

an equivalent undergraduate degree approved by the Media Honours Committee.

- Quality of applicant's Honours project proposal.
- Availability of appropriate supervision of applicant's Honours project.

The Media Honours Committee decides on applications based on these criteria. At its discretion the committee can consider applications which it deems suitable but which fall outside the above set criteria.
