

Chilla Bulbeck Prize Rules

Establishment

This Prize was established in 2013 to honour the contributions and work of Professor Emerita Chilla Bulbeck, a retired staff member of the Department of Sociology, Criminology & Gender Studies in the School of Social Sciences. The prize is supported by annual donations to the University from UnitingSA, a community-based not-for-profit organisation which assists over 20,000 people each year across the life continuum, from the very young to the elderly. UnitingSA will support the Prize for a further 3 years (2022 – 2024). Emerita Professor Chilla Bulbeck has also generously provided \$10,000 to endow the prize in perpetuity.

Rules

- 1. There shall be a Prize known as "The Chilla Bulbeck Prize".
- Two Prizes will be awarded by the University annually for the years 2021-2024, one being supported by UnitingSA and the other from the annual income available from the Endowment Fund. From 2025, subject to continuing UnitingSA support, only one prize will be awarded annually.
- 3. The value of each Prize will be \$500.00.
- 4. The Head of School will award the Prizes to the students enrolled in SOCI 1003 Introduction to Sociology and SOCI 1004 Social Problems who have demonstrated most improvement throughout the semester in terms of essay writing and who have also actively engaged in and understood the social justice implications discussed weekly in the lecture and tutorial sessions.
- 5. If in any particular year the Head of School considers that no candidate is suitable for a Prize, then no award shall be made.
- 6. The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
